

What will be expected of you in Year 5?

- You will be responsible for your water bottle, lunch, homework and PE kit (NOT your grown ups!)
- You must follow the BEE rules (Be safe, Be kind, Be respectful, Be proud) at all times
- You may be with a different teacher, in a different room, for Maths, Reading comprehension or SPAG. We expect you to move quietly, quickly and sensibly between these sessions.
- We expect you to show the same level of respect to all adults (your teachers, teaching assistants and middays)
- English (Spag) homework is given out on Tuesday, to be handed in Friday
- Maths homework is given out on Friday, to be handed in on Tuesday
- Spellings are given out on Wednesday and tested the following Wednesday
