

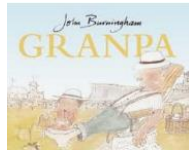
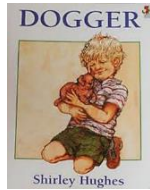

Subject Specific Vocabulary

Timeline	A line that shows the order in which events have happened.
Material	The substance that things are made from.
Telephone	A device for speaking to someone in another place.
Mobile	A phone that does not need a wire.
Toy	An object for children to play with.
Switchboard	Used in the past to direct telephone calls.
Computer	An electronic machine that can store and organise information.

Important Bits
