Curriculum Matters Year 1 Spring 2 2020

This half term we will be researching the history of our local area. We will focus on our school, Stalybridge and the different historical aspects of the locality. We will learn all about the life of LS Lowry who lived locally and look at his paintings. We will also be creating our own artwork based on some of his work.

English

During English this half term we will be:

- Reading poetry and writing our own spring poems.
- Identifying verbs and adjectives and using them in our writing.
- Developing writing through different fiction books and story characters.
- Writing longer sentences using conjunctions such as 'and', 'but' and 'because'.
- Becoming independent spellers using our phonics knowledge.
- We will continue to become confident and fluent readers in a wider range of text types.
- Secure knowledge and use of full stops and capital letters.
- Know and apply alphabetical order.

You can help your child at home by reading different types of non-fiction e.g. newspapers, labels, leaflets.

Morths

This half term our main areas of learning will be:

- Learning and applying use of doubles and halves.
- To understand multiplication and division through grouping and sharing.
- To count in twos fives and tens.
- To recognise half of an object is one of two equal parts.
- To recognise quarter of an object is one of four equal parts.

Target


Solve doubling problems e.g. if I buy one item for 6p, how much would two cost?

In music children will continue to:

- Learn Number Fun Songs
- Begin to understand, compose and use Musical Notation
- Use instruments to add effects in story telling

In art we will be using the work of LS Lowry to inspire our own paintings and drawings.
