Sticky Knowledge about places in the world including Hawaii

Hawaii is made up of 8 major islands. The climate is tropical.

The language spoken in Hawaii is English.

The largest volcano on earth is on Hawaii called Mauna Loa.

The five oceans are Pacific, Arctic, Atlantic, Indian and Southern.

The names of the seven continents and oceans are Europe, Antarctica, Africa, Asia, North and South America, Australasia

Subject Specific Vocabulary

Hawaii	The largest island in the Pacific Ocean
Island	A piece of land surrounded by sea.
Ocean	A large area of salt water between the continents.
Climate	Climate refers to aspects of weather e.g. hot country /hot climate. Tropical climate in areas close to the equator.
European	To be European is to be in a group of countries in the continent Europe
Beach	A pebbly or sandy shore between the sea and a higher land place.
Volcano	An opening in the earth's surface.
Continent	A large area of land
Cliff	A steep rock face at the edge of the sea.
Palm tree	A tree that grows in a tropical region with a tall, straight trunk and large leaves.
