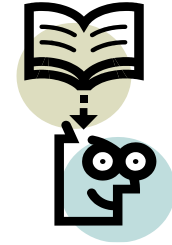


Autumn 2 year 3 Curriculum Matters

Literacy

We will mainly be focussing on;

- Non-chronological reports.
- Performance poetry.

Literacy Target

To read a wide variety of non-fiction texts and discuss how these are laid out differently to fiction.

Numeracy

We will be looking at formal Methods of addition and Subtraction as well as well as 3, 4 and 8 times tables and the related division facts.

- Choosing the correct calculations to solve worded problems.

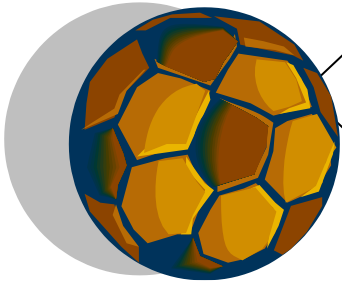
Numeracy Target
