

## Key Stage 1

### Drawing

I can draw lines of varying thickness

I can use dots and lines to demonstrate pattern and texture;

I can use different materials to draw, for example pastels, chalk, felt tips;

I can use key vocabulary to demonstrate knowledge and understanding: *portrait, self-portrait, line drawing, detail, landscape, cityscape, building, pastels, drawings, line, bold, size, space.*

### Painting

I can name the primary and secondary colours;

I can experiment with different brushes (including brushstrokes) and other painting tools;

I can mix primary colours to make secondary colours;

I can add white and black to alter tints and shades;

I can use key vocabulary to demonstrate knowledge and understanding: *primary colours, secondary colours, neutral colours, tints, shades, warm colours, cool colours, watercolour wash, sweep, dab, bold brushstroke, acrylic paint.*

### Sculpture

I can use a variety of natural, recycled and manufactured materials for sculpting, e.g. clay, straw and card;

I can use a variety of techniques, e.g. rolling, cutting, pinching;

I can use a variety of shapes, including lines and texture;

I can use key vocabulary to demonstrate knowledge and understanding: *sculpture, statue, model, work, work of art, 3D, land art, sculptor, carving, sculpture, collage, weave, installation, shapes, materials, pyramid, abstract, geometric.*

### Artist Study

I can describe the work of famous, notable artists and designers;

I can express an opinion on the work of famous, notable artists;

I can use inspiration from famous, notable artists to create their own work and compare;
