

Curriculum Matters Summer 1

Science

Our theme this half term in Year 6 is 'The Heart and Circulatory System', which is primarily a science based topic. Children will cover the following learning objectives:

- Look at the structure of the human heart and understand its various parts
- Find out more about the 'figure of 8' double circulation in humans
- Find out about the many important functions related to blood
- Learn about the effects of exercise and healthy living associated to the heart and the circulatory system

English


This half term, we shall be working on reading comprehension techniques in preparation for our KS2 SATs, concentrating on the skills of fact retrieval, inference and deduction, word meaning and structure.

We will also revise reading and writing a number of genres in English, such as stories, reports and letters. We will focus on audience, purpose and cohesion. Children will be encouraged to verbalise, draft and edit writing pieces which will be moderated during Summer 2. Children will also be using and applying their writing skills to other cross-curricular activities such as within the Science topic outlined above.

Target: To identify and use the key features required for a range of different genres.



Mathematics



This half term, we will be working on problem solving including multi-step questions and revising written methods for performing operations. Additionally we will aim to further improve speed and accuracy of key arithmetic calculations in preparation for the KS2 SATs. We will also be revising a number of mathematical areas and concepts that we identify as requiring attention. We encourage children to utilise the SATs revision booklets provided. We will also cover shape and statistics. We will be using our mathematical skills of data handling, through a cross curricular approach, to support the Science theme.

Target: To apply key skills acquired in lessons, in solving SATs-type problem solving.

Computing

To link in with our work on the heart, children will be producing data bases and interpreting a range of data handling programs.



MUSIC

We will continue to work on our recorder skills with Mrs Stone as well as developing our understanding of percussion instruments.




PE
