Year 1 Summer 1



Our geography based theme this half term is 'Where in the U.K. is Barnaby Bear?' We will follow Barnaby on his travels around the United Kingdom and explore different human and physical features. We will investigate different capital cities of the U.K. and how Barnaby might travel to his different destinations. We will also learn about the seas that surround the U.K.

English

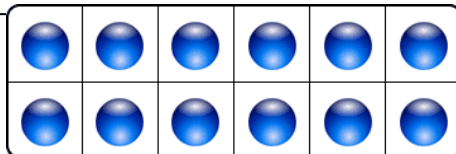


This half term we are going to be looking at a range of different texts. We will start by reading 'Beegu' and 'The Rainbow Fish' and use these stories to inspire our own descriptive writing. We will be reading and writing non-fiction texts and we will continue to explore the key features of fiction and non-fiction. In poetry we will focus on performance poetry and how to use our voices to help tell a story or poem. We will also be looking at using additional punctuation such as question and exclamation marks. We will continue our phonics catch up, please listen to your child read at home regularly to help them apply their phonic knowledge.

Maths

This half term our main areas of learning will be:

- To find halves and quarters of shapes and amounts.
- To recognise equal groups.
- To make doubles.
- To count in multiples of 2's, 5's and 10's.
- To make equal groups by sharing and make an array.



Music

- We will be learning what an ostinato is and how they are used.
- We will listen to different rhythms and pitches.
- Listen to and watch performances of popular modern classics.



R.E.

We will be learning what it means to belong to a faith community.



P.E.

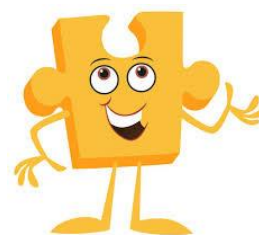
Children may be having P.E. outdoors if the weather permits. Year One P.E. is on a Tuesday morning. Please come to school on a Tuesday in PE kit.
