These are the learning objectives we are working on this half term in Literacy

- Extending and improving our vocabulary through books and talking times
- Writing CVC words and tricky and high frequency words
- Hearing and identifying sounds in words
- Practising letter formation
- Sounding out words and blending the sounds in order to read simple words
- Talking about stories, characters and events
- Answering questions about books that we have read.
- Making up our own stories developing our imagination



These are the learning objectives we are working on in Maths

- Looking at the properties of circles and triangles and exploring four sided shapes.
- Practising counting in different ways; forward to twenty from different starting point, backwards from ten.
- Exploring the composition of numbers to five and being able to see five things without counting (subitising)
- Practising counting accurately and knowing one more and less for numbers to five.
- Engaging in problem solving activities
