





### First Hand / Real Life Learning Experiences

UW (History)

Looking at artefacts of old toys and new toys

A talk from a grandma/grandad about toys when they were little

Questionnaire to send home to ask older grownups/research

Posting pictures/letters to the king

# UW (Science) (History) what did the queen play with when she was a girl?

- Naming different old toys
- Understanding the different materials that toys were/are made of
- Looking at how toys move/ what is used
- Understanding the concept of inventions and how some toys that they have now did not exist when the king was a boy
- Learning about a historical figure/ the king of England (Charles III)

### **Important Facts:**

- That the toys that the king/great grandparents played with were very different to ours
- That people have different likes and dislikes
- The old toys were often made of different, materials because some materials had not been invented yet.

### **Key Vocabulary**

Invention, old, plastic, metal, wood, electricity

### **Key Questions**

- Can children identify the differences between toys then and now?
- Do children understand that people like, dislike different things, and have different opinions; understand that their favourite toy may not be another child's favourite (revisit this concept from Autumn 1)
