

Year 2 Curriculum Matters



Spring 1

Our theme for this half term is "Who left the bread in the oven?" This is a <u>History and Geography</u> topic which involves researching the causes and effects of The Great Fire of London. We will look at how we know what happened through Samuel Pepys diaries and other evidence. We will find out what London was like then and compare it to our capital city today!

<u>English</u>

In English we will be linking our work to the theme "The Great Fire of London" We will be looking at different recounts and writing a diary extract.

We will also be looking at and reading a selection of books by the same author. We will study books in the series of Mr Men books by Roger Hargreaves

- I use capital letters for names of people, places, days of the week and the personal pronoun 'I'.
- I consistently use the present tense and past tense correctly.



Maths

Problem solving will be interwoven with all our units of work. We will focus on multiplying and dividing by gathering and sharing objects. Counting, addition and subtraction will continue to be priorities in money tasks and Maths skills sessions.

- To use pounds and pence and find change
- To begin to multiply and divide using concrete materials

Reading

Please continue to listen to your child read regularly and write a comment in the blue 'reading record'. Their reading book will be changed weekly and they will continue to be heard in a weekly guided reading session, and where possible some children will be listened to individually. In addition, children will take part in whole class reading sessions to improve fluency and practise a variety of reading skills.

Art

We will learn the difference between 'landscape' and 'portrait' pictures. We will use our knowledge and imagination to create pictures representing 'The Great Fire of London'. To do this we will experiment with a variety of tools and techniques.



ICT

We will learn how to test and debug algorithms. We will learn.

Walk forwards a number of steps.

Turn a quarter turn.

Walk squares and rectangles.

Give and follow instructions.

Write an algorithm for a shape or route.

Debug errors in algorithms.

Music

In music we will look at the difference between high and low sounds and we will create simple melodic patterns.
