
44 CURRICULUM MATTERS SPRING 1



This half term, our theme is called 'Where DO the raindrops go?' This centres around the water cycle, rivers and mountains and links to geography and

science. We will look at why water is so important

and how it varies geographically between different places. We will also conduct various experiments to explore the following objectives from the National Curriculum:



- compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids,
 liquids or gases
- observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C)
- identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.







In English, we will start off with newspaper reports on a natural disaster and this will focus on the skills and features required to write a newspaper article. The children will then focus on an explanation text to help us write an explanation of how the water cycle works. In general, we will be using our English skills, including reading, writing, spelling, grammar and punctuation, across all areas of the curriculum to ensure they are embedded.

English Target: To ensure their writing is varied and interesting by using fronted adverbials, conjunctions and a variety of punctuation. Then to proofread it CAREFULLY!







The children will be focusing on some of the following topics this half term as outlined in the National Curriculum: We will be learning about factor numbers. We will also be continuing with multiplication; x10 x100 and related facts, as well as formal and informal written methods and how to multiply efficiently.

HOME TARGET: To continue to learn the multiplication facts all the way up to 12×12 (and related division facts).
