### As Staff and Governors at Gorse Hall school we will:

- Ensure we promote a healthy life style and promote exercise
- Ensure everyone is happy and safe
- Have a clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy
- Encourage children to follow the Bee rules and develop a caring attitude towards the school community and the environment
- Teach and encourage the children to do their best and achieve their full potential
- Provide a balanced and broad curriculum that challenges and supports all pupils
- Set regular homework and to mark it if appropriate;
- Inform children and parents/carers what the teachers aim to teach the children each half term
- Contact parents/carers as soon as concerns are raised about your child's work, behaviour, attendance or punctuality
- Communicate between home and school through notices, text messages, newsletters, website and general meetings

### As Parents and Carers of pupils at Gorse Hall School we will:

- Not send our child in school if we believe them to be unwell or we believe
- Ensure the Bee rules and expectations are adhered to
- Make sure that my child attends school regularly; is punctual; properly equipped; and ready to learn
- Ensure my child has correct uniform and comes to school without any jewellery
- Inform the school on the first day of absence
- Raise any concerns or problems that might affect my child's ability to learn or behave appropriately
- Support the school to make sure my child maintains good behaviour
- Support my child with homework and other home learning opportunities and listen to my child read daily
- Attend parent consultations with the teacher to discuss my child's achievements and progress
- Support all staff in their efforts to create a caring community which values children and their rights
- Support the school in getting any help my child may need
- Read all letters, emails and messages that are sent home
- Inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details

### As pupils of Gorse Hall School we will:

- Tell an adult if we are feeling unwell keep ourselves safe at all times and follow the Bee rules and expectations
- Be ready to learn
- Bring all the equipment I need every day including my PE kit, book bag and reading books
- Make sure I am wearing my full uniform
- Work hard and listen carefully to instructions
- Come to school regularly and on time
- Follow the Bee rules and expectations
- Behave well at all times of the day and maintain the safety of myself and others
- Be polite, friendly and helpful to other children
- Treat all adults with respect
- Tell somebody if there is something I am not happy about
- Do my homework regularly and return it to school on time
- Take good care of the school, its' belongings and our local community.
