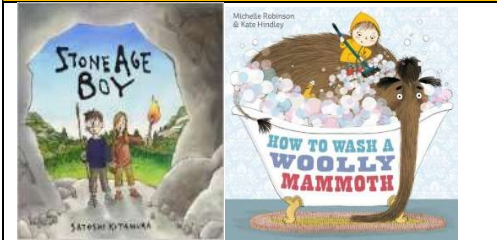

Sticky Knowledge about the Stone Age period

- The stone-age period is said to have started around 3 million years ago. This is a period of pre-history.
- The stone-age was followed by the bronze-age period. This is when humans started to use metal.
- The bronze-age was followed by the iron-age when tools and weapons became more advanced.
- During the Palaeolithic Age (old stone age), man gathered food by hunting wild animals and birds, fishing, and collecting fruits and nuts.
- During the Neolithic Age (towards end of the stone-age), the humans made farms and settled there. People began to trade goods such as crops with each other.
- We know about the Stone Age because of important artefacts such as; Stonehenge and Skara Brae.

Cave paintings	Cave paintings were left as a celebration of hunting and life in the Stone Age
Flint	A stone used to make weapons in the Stone Age.
Trade	Exchanging, buying or selling goods.
Settlement	Places where people live.
