

## What will be expected of me in Year 3?

- I will bring a drinks bottle every day.
- I will come into school in my PE kit on my allocated PE day.
   My PE kit MUST be black bottoms (jogging bottoms/leggings/shorts) and a plain white T-shirt.
- I will bring my reading book into school every day.
- We don't bring in toys or things from home, unless it is for Show and Tell.
- I will stay in my seat at my table when I am working
- I will follow the BEE rules (Be safe, Be kind, Be respectful, Be proud)
- I will get homework on a Friday. Homework needs to be returned by Wednesday the next week. I will put completed homework in a tray at the front of the classroom and I will tick my name off so the teachers know I have done it.
- I will put all letters in my reading folder and make sure that my parents / guardians get these letters. (The teachers will not look in my reading folder for things)
- I will always try my best.
- I will always speak to a grown up if something is bothering me.
- I will always ask if I want to leave the room i.e. to go to the toilet.
- At hometime I will stay in the line until my name is called and then I will go outside and straight to my grown up.
