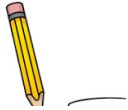


# Curriculum Matters



Our theme this half term is the Stone Age. This is primarily a history topic. We will place the Stone Age on a timeline before moving onto looking at everyday life in the Stone Age.



## English

- **Narrative** - different styles of story writing with a focus on 'Stone Age Boy'.
- **Non- Fiction** - We will be looking at instructional texts and learning how to write our own instructions.

**Target:** To punctuate speech and dialogue in writing using speech marks.

Please make sure you read a wide variety of books with your child, including school books and books of their choice.

## Maths



We will be concentrating on

- Place Value of 3 digit numbers.
- Adding and subtracting 3 digit numbers including adding and subtracting 1s, 10s and 100s to a 3 digit number.
- Using formal methods for addition and subtraction.

**Target:** To know the value of each digit in a 3 digit number.

### Computing

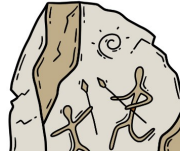
We will be focussing on online safety. Children will be taught how to stay safe online. We will also discuss cyberbullying.

## RE/Music/Art

In Re we will be asking the question, "What do different people believe about God?"

In Art we will be looking at Stone Age art.

In Music we will be learning to play the Ocarina and exploring beat and rhythm.
