### Maths—Nursery

We are encouraging the children to use their magic counting finger as they count and to touch each object as they do so. We will also be looking at objects in a five frame.

We will be talking about fairy tales and in particular those that have three charac-



ters... Three Bears, Three Billy Goats Gruff, Three Pigs. We will be encouraging the children to retell and sequence the story and also look at the internet and non-fiction books to find out about different animals.
