


# My Transition Booklet Elm Class

# These are toilets in the classroom that I will use.






These are doors that will enter and leave school from. I will wait behind the green fence in the morning until the bell rings.

#### What will be expected of me in Reception?

- I will bring a suitable coat everyday as we go outside in all weathers.
- I will bring a drinks **bottle** every day with my NAME on.
- I will come into school in my PE kit on my PE day (day to be allocated in September).
- My PE kit MUST be black bottoms (jogging bottoms/leggings/shorts) and a plain white T-shirt with black trainers.
- I will bring my **reading folder** into school **every day**
- We don't bring in toys or things from home, unless it has been arranged first (show and tell)
- I will follow the **BEE** rules (Be safe, Be kind, Be respectful, Be proud)
- I will always try my best
- I will always speak to a grown up if something is bothering me
- At hometime, I will stay where I am until my name is called and then I will go outside and straight to my grown up.

9. 10am	Carpet whole class time (Topic/English)
9.30 am	Focus learning/independent learning

10:15am	Phonics
10.35 am	Snack time/story – Wash hands
10.50 am	Focus learning/independent learning
11:30 am	Carpet time - story time
11:45 am	Wash hands - Dinner
1:00 pm	Carpet Whole Class Time (Maths)
1.30 pm	Readers/focus groups/independent learning
2.30 pm	Tidy up time
2.45 pm	Story time / singing time / Show and Tell
3.15 pm	Home time
