



Y4 Curriculum Matters – Spring 2



Our theme for Spring 2 term is 'Sound and electricity', which is a science based topic. The children will explore and identify the way sound is made through vibration in a range of different musical instruments from around the world; and find out how the pitch and volume of sounds can be changed in a variety of ways.

The children will also begin to make simple circuits using the correct symbols. They will look at different electrical appliances and the dangers of electricity.



English



Maths



In English this half term, the children will be focusing on writing their own stories based on James and the Giant Peach. They will also be looking at different forms of poetry.

In addition to this, the children will continue learning:

- to use paragraphs,
- to use a range of conjunctions (but, so, because, although, when, if)
- fronted adverbials with commas (In the afternoon,)
- expanded noun phrases (the tall, skinny man)

English Target: to identify the above features in books at home

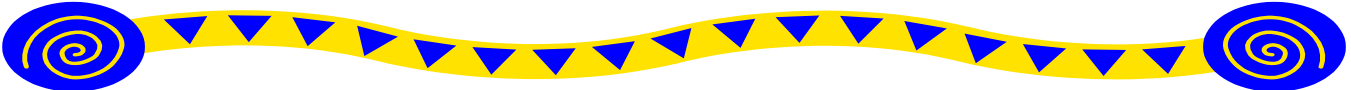
We will be focusing on the following topics this half term:

- Length and Perimeter
- Fractions and Decimals: adding and subtracting simple fractions, ordering fractions and decimals, identifying equivalent fractions and decimals.

Maths Target: to continue to practise your times tables and identify the related division facts e.g.

$6 \times 7 = 42$ $42 \div 7 = 6$

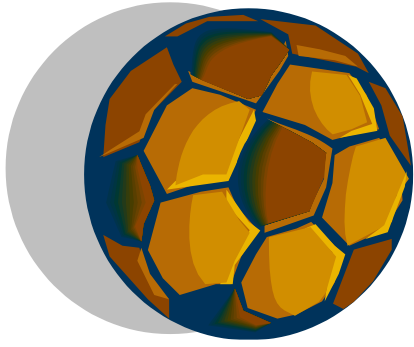

Design and Technology

In Design and Technology, the children will be undertaking a design task based around our theme of electricity and how to incorporate building a circuit into a working model.
